Public Transport From Glasgow City Centre:

Bus: The 3, 38, 38B, 57 and 57A bus stop near both Queen Street and Central Station and drop off at Coplaw Street bus stop - 3 mins walk from Tramway.

Train: From Central Station High Level take trains marked Neilston, Newton or Cathcart Circle to Pollokshields East station, 1 min walk from Tramway.

Note: Pollokshields East station is not wheelchair accessible and requires the use of several stairs.

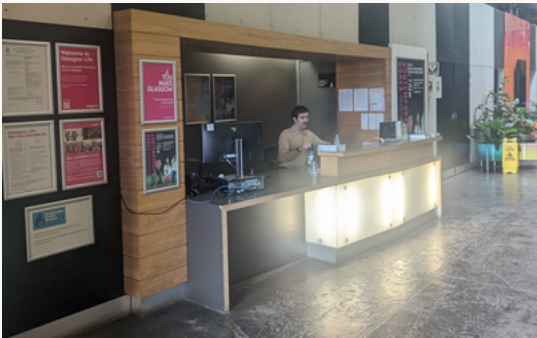
Subway: Take the Subway to Bridge Street station then take the 3, 38, 38B, 57 or 57A bus to Coplaw Street bus stop.

Building Entrance



Box Office Reception



Located immediately on your left on entering Tramway.

Staff at this desk can provide information, sell tickets and support with any access information.

T5 Gallery



Located immediately on your right on entering Tramway.

At the entrance to the gallery you will find information about the artist and exhibition.

T2 Gallery

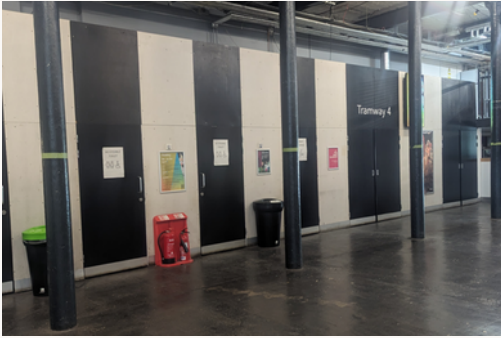


Located behind the large staircase and to the right of the passenger lift.

At the entrance to the gallery you will find information about the artist and exhibition.

Tramway walkthrough

Accessible toilets and baby change



Located around halfway into the building on the far left-hand side. A detailed visual guide is available that provides measurements and photos of these spaces.

Gender neutral toilets



Gender neutral toilets are located to the left of the passenger lift, along a short corridor. The toilets are identified by their sanitaryware - Stalls Only and Stalls & Urinals

Café Bar



The Café Bar is located towards the back of the building.

None of the seats in the Café Bar are fixed and so can be moved around on request to accommodate required wheelchair or mobility space.

Hidden Gardens



The Hidden Gardens are located at the very back of the building, through the café, on the ground floor.

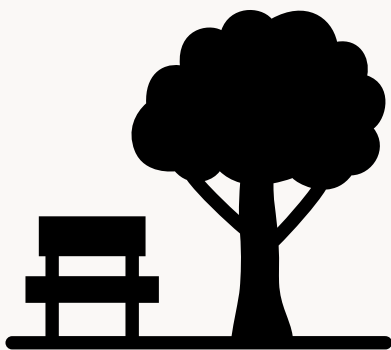
Content notes

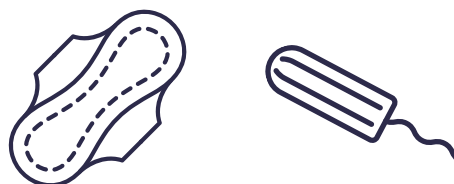

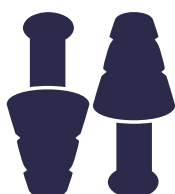

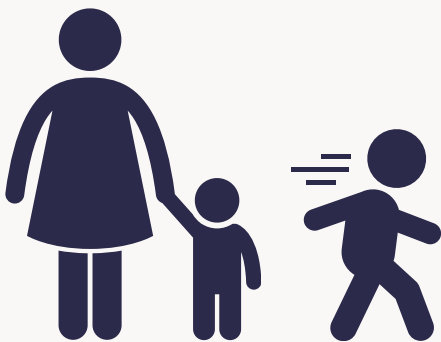
'Our Gallery Staff have a dual role; welcoming you to our spaces and answering your questions, and looking after the artworks in the space.'

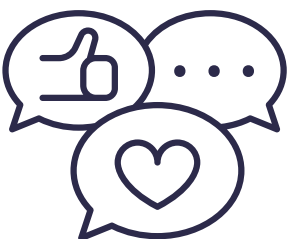
